

2010 Eldon Demolition Derby

Big Car and General Safety Rules

Eldon Derby - June 20th, 2010 4:00pm

1. All drivers must wear helmet, eye protection and seat belt.
2. All passenger cars and station wagons must be 1967 and newer. NO Imperials or components 1971 and before.
3. No changing car brands of rear ends, motor, or tranny.
* Must be original for type of car!
4. No welding on car other than drivers door, #9 wire or chain must be used on doors and trunk. No wire around the frame. THERE WILL BE AN OFF HOOD INSPECTION!!
 - A. Spider gears can be welded.
 - B. 6 Bolts can be welded to hold hood on; bolts can be welded on 6"x 6" pads.
 - C. Stock body mounts, no mounts and you will not run, stock bolts or 3/4" bolts can replace them.
 - D. Can have a Distributor protector and a Carburetor protector.
 - E. May weld bumper to shocks, shock and mounts.
(We do not want bumpers to fall off!)
 - F. Can have two – 2" steel straps on both bumpers to radiator support and trunk lid.
 - G. Excessive use of wire will be determined by judges. (Bring your cutters)
5. Cars can have one pipe or bar behind driver's seat, from doorpost to doorpost and one cowl bar from windshield post to windshield post. Also, you can run door bars to connect pipes. NO Bars to frame.
6. All glass and chrome must be removed before entering pit area.
7. Maximum 15" tires and 8-ply rating. NO implement tires, no double tires, only air in tires.
8. Radiator must be in stock location.
9. Gas tank must be secured and covered inside of car. No original tanks, must be a boat tank or fuel cell, 6-gallon max. Fuel line must be positively attached to tank.
10. Battery must be moved to inside the car and be secured and covered.
11. Fender may be cut to diameter of tire.
12. Trunk must be empty. No ballast.
13. All cars must have a hood. It is mandatory that an opening be cut in the hood over the carburetor, approximately 8" square or larger. In addition, a hole must be cut in the trunk if the judges cannot see inside.
14. Car must have sign on top of car with number.
15. No profanity or obscenities on car.
16. All trash, parts, cans, etc. need to be picked up before leaving.
17. All cars must be removed within 24 hours after event.
18. Any rules not covered will be left up to officials.
19. Judges decisions will be FINAL.
20. Entry fee allows car and driver only.
21. Car check in at 1- 3 pm. Derby Starts at 4 pm. Be on time!
22. Drivers meeting 15 minutes before derby starts.

Compact Car Class Rules

1. All cars must be front wheel drive, 4 cyl. and 6 cyl. ONLY.
2. You can run any bumpers, big car or compact car. Weld them on good!
3. All rules for Big car class and general rules apply to compact cars.
